We close the season on **April 22** with **Awake and Aflame**, a blazing finale featuring **violinist Nathan Meltzer and a stellar ensemble** in works by Caroline Shaw, Granados, and Brahms.



Vitaly Starikov, the 2025 Van Cliburn Silver Medalist, takes the stage for Fractured Time, a riveting solo recital of Chopin's Études, Op. 25 and Debussy's 12 Études. These works fracture, bend, and suspend time itself —Chopin's surging Romanticism colliding with Debussy's shimmering modernism—revealing music as both mirror and escape, where emotion refuses to sit still.

A laureate of major international competitions including the **Queen Elisabeth** and **Sydney International**, Russian pianist **Vitaly Starikov** has captivated audiences and critics alike with his virtuosity, imagination, and poetic insight.
